



Cuff Sizing

To help us determine which size of cuff to send you, take a section of string, and wrap around the circumference of your wrist. Make sure to measure the part of your wrist that is just beyond your wrist bone, on the side of the wrist that is toward your elbow, versus the hand side of your wrist bone. Mark the string and measure as accurately as possible. Double check your measurement by repeating. If possible, measure in inches (millimeters are acceptable), and give the exact measurement to the 1/8in or millimeter. We will use your measurement to determine which size cuff will work best. Each Cuff design is available in three sizes that will allow a nice fit for both men and women, across a wide range of wrist sizes. Please don't assume your size, as a petite woman would not necessarily not necessarily size for a small. **NOTE:** *Upon receiving your bracelet, you can further customize the size, tighter or looser, by slightly bending the bracelet in or out. Bending the cuff should only be done once, and is not meant to be a method of putting on or removing your cuff.*

GIVING THE CUFF AS A GIFT: If you are giving the bracelet as a gift, we can offer other solutions as to determining the size required. One method is to have someone trace the inside of any bracelet the recipient may already wear, or a watch will a

BENDING THE YOUR CUFF TO ACHIEVE A BETTER FIT: Although we guarantee the fit, upon receiving your bracelet, we ask that you not bend the bracelet in or out, until you establish that the fit it very close, without any bending at all. If the fit is not close, either by difficulty or excessive ease of putting the bracelet on, or by how the bracelet feels once it is on, we will have you return the bracelet to us, and ship free of charge, a different size back to you. ***Sometimes the bracelet may be difficult to put on, but once on, it feels perfect. In this case, bending is not needed. Avoid bending the bracelet in, then out, or visa versa. Each bending weakens the metal, and may eventually compromise the integrity of the bracelet. Bending the bracelet should only be done once to achieve your optimal fit.***
